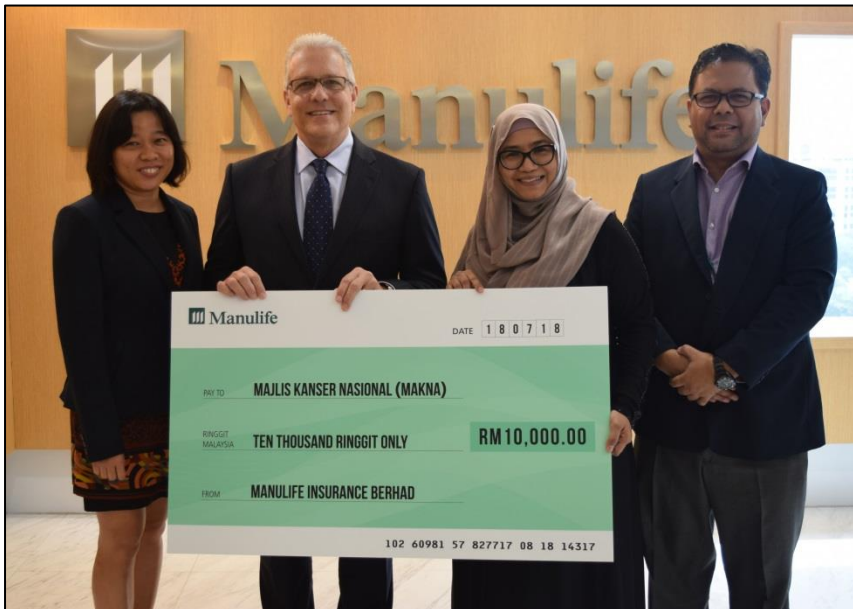


Manulife lends a helping hand to MAKNA
